INFORMATION ABOUT THE EVENT

The organizer of the scientific and pedagogical internship on the topic "Adaptation of the specialist training system in higher education to the modern challenges of the european educational space" is the ŚWIĘTOKRZYSKA SZKOŁA WYŻSZA w. Kielcach im. św. Jana Pawła II (Kielce, Poland), with support in Ukraine from the Research and Educational Innovation Center of Social Transformations (Chernihiv, Ukraine).

The internship is conducted **without a break from work**, in accordance with the legislation of both countries in the field of postgraduate and distance education. **The internship program includes:** familiarization with the history of the development of the educational institution through the official information portal; acquaintance with the range of profile educational programs, as well as educational and methodological materials; preparation of a scientific and pedagogical essay (theses of internship reports) on the chosen issue (the applicant's profile); receiving a collection of works and an international certificate of completion of the internship program with the signature of the program supervisor. **The collection of scientific and pedagogical essays (theses of internship reports) will have: ISBN, indexing in Google Scholar, and a DOI for each essay.**

The scientific and pedagogical internship program without a break from work is 6 credits (180 hours) and includes the following parts:

- Virtual tour through the official information platform of the [Świętokrzyska Szkoła Wyższa w. Kielcach im. św. Jana Pawła II](#) – 10 hours;
- Familiarization with the spectrum of [educational directions](#), distance learning system – 20 hours;
- Familiarization with the system of strategic management of modern higher education institutions in Poland (using the example of the [Development Strategy](#) of the Świętokrzyska Szkoła Wyższa w. Kielcach im. św. Jana Pawła II) – 50 hours;

– Study of the approach to learning as a continuous process (lifelong learning) – experience of the [University of the Third Age](#) of the Świętokrzyska Szkoła Wyższa w. Kielcach im. św. Jana Pawła II – 30 hours;

– Independent work with the [library fund](#) (electronic educational and scientific resources) – 30 hours;

– Preparation of a scientific and pedagogical essay (theses of internship reports) on the chosen issue (the applicant's profile) – 40 hours.

All types of work by the internship participant are **carried out independently**.

After successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Certificate of Scientific and Pedagogical Internship at an EU higher education institution in paper form, as well as a collection of scientific and pedagogical essays (theses of internship reports) in electronic form.

The Certificate of Completion of the Scientific and Pedagogical Internship is a document that confirms the international experience of the candidate for obtaining the academic titles of associate professor, senior researcher, and professor in accordance with the Procedure for approving decisions on awarding academic titles in Ukraine. It is also taken into account in licensing and accrediting educational services.

2) A scanned copy of the payment receipt for the organizational fee to the email address internship@reicst.com.ua.

3) Scientific and pedagogical essay (theses of internship reports) on the profile of the applicant's work – **by May 6, 2025**. The file name should correspond to the author's last name, for example, Shevchenko_essay.doc.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FORMAT OF SCIENTIFIC-PEDAGOGICAL ESSAYS (THESIS OF INTERNSHIP REPORTS)

Essays (theses of internship reports) should be submitted by May 6, 2025.

A scientific-pedagogical essay (theses of internship reports) is an individual analytical or scientific-methodical work by the author with a volume of up to 10 pages. The essay (theses of internship reports) begin with a clearly formulated problem and include the rationale for the problematic situation specific to the field of knowledge in which the author is undergoing internship. The work should be analytical or scientific-methodical in content, with clear argumentation, the author's position, and, if necessary, include the experience of EU countries. The author is required to independently formulate the conclusions of the work.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ESSAY FORMATTING:

- Volume: up to 10 pages, typed in the MS Word text editor;
- Orientation: portrait;
- Margins on all sides: 20 mm.

SEQUENCE OF PLACEMENT OF MATERIALS IN A SCIENTIFIC ESSAY:

– First and subsequent lines in English (or Polish): author's surname and initials, academic degree and title (if applicable), position, place of work/study, city, country, ORCID (font - italic, semi-bold, font size 14, center alignment, no paragraph indents, line spacing - 1.5);

– One line below in Ukrainian: author's surname and initials, academic degree and title (if applicable), position, place of work/study (font - italic, semi-bold, font size 14, center alignment, no paragraph indents, line spacing - 1.5);

– One line below: Title of the essay in English (or Polish) (font - bold, all uppercase, font size 14, center alignment, no paragraph indents, line spacing - 1.5);

– Next line: Title of the essay in Ukrainian (font - bold, all uppercase, font size 14, center alignment, no paragraph indents, line spacing - 1.5);

– Next line: Essay text (font - semi-bold, all uppercase, font size 14, full justification, paragraph indent - 1.25, line spacing - 1.5). In the text, footnotes are indicated by square brackets with the source's ordinal number from the list and, if necessary, the page number (pages), for example, [5, p.20];

– *If necessary* - Literature/References (font - semi-bold, all uppercase, font size 12, width alignment, paragraph indent - 1.25, line spacing - 1.15) should be formatted in APA style (Formatting Guide: <https://drive.google.com/file/d/15emySdJbNVt79dl83dJkChjg5PFjKsa/view>).

Languages of the scientific essay: Polish, English, Ukrainian.
